What we know

Alcohol use among middle schoolers has declined by more than half since 2000. We can continue this trend until alcohol use is no longer a threat to our youth. Unfortunately, a new challenge is threatening Vernon youth: opioid and prescription drug use is on the rise.

- A higher percentage of students in grades 6-8 reported using prescription drugs than any other core drug category.
- Reported prescription drug use among students in grades 9-12 in 2013 increased from 2009 and was higher than the regional rate.
