



#### **Long Term Effects of Vaping**



For a while, we have speculated that vaping may not be as good for the human body as it has been marketed to make

people believe, but the long term effects were not yet known. Now, the American Journal of Preventative Medicine has released findings from a three-year study that shows vaping is an independent risk factor to lung and respiratory diseases such as COPD, chronic bronchitis, emphysema, and asthma.

#### 2019 Monitoring the Future Survey Results

"Monitoring the Future" is a national annual survey of 8th, 10th, and 12th graders conducted by researchers.



Since 1975, the survey has measured how teens report their drug, alcohol, and cigarette use and related attitudes nationwide.

42,531 students from 396 public and private schools participated in the 2019 survey.


