## National Drug and Alcohol Facts Week

National Drug and Alcohol Facts Weeks (NDAFW) is an annual, week-long observance occurring from March 30- April 4th. It aims to educate and debunk myths about substances teens commonly misuse.

Youth are greatly influenced by things they see in movies, TV and music, and by what celebrities say and do. When the content they consume is saturated with drug and alcohol use it gives them the perception that they are harmless.

While it is important to have frequent conversations regarding substances with young people, we need to make it a priority during this week by providing education and accurate facts to show that substance use is not all the glitz and glam as it appears on TV and other media outlets. Rather, it can have serious consequences to a person's health, safety, and overall and social well-being.





## Lawsuit Against BigVape

Connecticut's Attorney General, William Tong, is standing at the forefront of the multistate lawsuit against e-cigarette manufacturer, JUUL Labs. The investigation includes 39 states and focuses on the company's use of deceptive marketing strategies which lead to an exponential amount of youth becoming addicted to them.

Vaping is a growing problem among youth. The 2019 National Youth Tobacco Survey results showed "more than 5 million youth reporting having used e-cigarettes in the past 30 days" and nearly 1 million reporting daily use, according to <u>fda.gov.</u>
