August 22nd, we had the pleasure of attending Freshman Orientation and meeting the incoming RHS freshman class! Vernon ROCKS was a stop on the school tour to educate incoming freshman on mental health, dispel misconceptions about common substances, and provide healthy coping strategies for stress. We had an iPad with true or false questions using RHS data from the Youth Voices Count Survey. Thank you RHS for allowing us to be a part of this event. We cannot wait to interact more with the new class of students and help influence positive decision-making!
