
Sticker Shock

Vernon Youth Voices Survey 2023 Data Released!






Our 2023 Vernon Youth Voices Count Survey data has officially been released! This comprehensive report is based on 1,350 surveys submitted by students in grades 6-12 in Vernon.

This data empowers us to gain comprehensive insights into the prevailing trends and challenges faced by youth in our community. This knowledge can help us to tailor our efforts and interventions to address the specific needs of the youth, ensuring that our initiatives are well-informed and impactful. The data also increases awareness among parents and youth, enabling them to make informed decisions and navigate the community safely. We strive to create a healthier and safer environment for our community's future generations.

Notably, the statistics reveal significant shifts since our last survey. Marijuana has surpassed alcohol as the most commonly used substance among youth. In grades 9-12, 46% of students reported a low perceived risk of harm from THC. While legislative changes in recent years may have influenced perceptions of marijuana, it is crucial to emphasize that its consumption remains unsafe for youth.

Regarding substance access, our findings indicate that youth in grades 6-12 primarily obtain vape products and marijuana from friends and peers. Alcohol, on the other hand, is most frequently accessed with parental permission at home, echoing the importance of our recent social marketing campaign and the Social Host Law.
